PARENT INFORMATION





The Joseph Banks Secondary College Athletics Carnival will be held on Thursday 31st August, with staff and students currently preparing for a huge day of events.

The Athletics Carnival is a compulsory school day – all students are expected to be in attendance. We have a range of activities and events planned for the day as outlined in the schedule below, including a combination of individual events (track & field), relays and novelty events. Students who excel in the individual events will be selected for the Interschool Athletics Team which will compete at the SSWA event at State Athletics Centre early in Term 4.

If students have a track and a field event within the same 45 minute block, they are required to sign in at the field event first and then move straight to the track event to be marshalled. Once they have completed their track event, they can return to their field event and complete it.

Students are encouraged to enter as many events as possible to ensure they are accumulating points for their House. All students score points for participating, including the novelty events, so having a go is really important in terms of determining the winning House!

On the day, for parents:

- In the attached map, you will see we have allocated shade tents for parents.
- Please bring along your folding chairs or picnic blankets and set them up in the allocated areas. We thank you for your support with this.
- The Xenia Café will be selling food and drink for purchase throughout the day. This is located at the City of Wanneroo clubrooms.
- Please do not cross the track during the day. We have one point for students to cross and we would like to avoid delays or collisions with running events. This has been indicated in red on the map.
- If you would like to be involved in timekeeping or recording on the day please report to the PA tent at 9:00am.

We are looking forward to the day and to seeing which House will be the recipients of the Athletics Shield!

STUDENT INFORMATION

- Bring water to drink, and their food for the day. Students
 may wish to purchase food and drink from the College
 Xenia Café which will be located at the City of
 Wanneroo clubrooms.
- Wear a hat, and sun cream on the day, particularly if it is warm
- Wear their normal school sports uniform the only alternative being they may wear a t-shirt in their house colour if they have it. Students will also receive a coloured wristband in their house colour.
- Apply any coloured hairspray before coming to school, as no aerosols are permitted at the College.
- Please note: Students are expected to be in their house bays or participating in events throughout the day.
- You will need to meet at your HOUSE TENT at 8.45am, for attendance and distribution of wristbands and student number. Don't be late!

ON THE DAY



Our first events will start at 9.15am sharp. Listen to your house leader and check the program to know where you have to be and when!

For the novelty events – rally your team members – remember everyone who participates earns points for their house, the winning house doesn't need the fastest runners, they need students who participate and have a go!






