

Student Scholarships - Middle School

Joseph Banks Secondary College has expanded our Scholarship categories to cater for the wide variety of High Performance and Specialised programs we offer. Students who are able to demonstrate achievement in fields of endeavour related to school life are encouraged to apply.

Please note that the following documentation is required to be submitted as part of the scholarship application **before the end of Term One** to the Main Reception at Joseph Banks Secondary College:

- Application form to be completed in the student's handwriting.
- Student's latest school report, a copy of which must be attached to the application form.
- Completed teacher reference and personal reference.

It is expected that scholarship recipients will demonstrate a high level of commitment to their studies and be positively involved within the College. An overview of each Middle School scholarship is provided below:

Academic Scholarship

Students who demonstrate strong academic performance will be eligible to apply for an Academic scholarship. This scholarship will include financial support of \$150 towards their course charges per year from Year 7 to the completion of Year 9.

Citizenship Scholarship

Students who are positively involved within the College and in the local community are eligible to apply for a Citizenship Scholarship. This scholarship will include financial support of \$150 towards their course charges per year from Year 7 to the completion of Year 9.

High Performance Academic Extension Program - ASPIRE Scholarship

The High Performance Academic Extension Program Scholarship will provide financial support to students who demonstrate a strong dedication to learning.

To be eligible students must have achieved high standards in at least two categories of NAPLAN. This scholarship will include financial support of \$150 towards their course charges per year from Year 7 to the completion of Year 9.

High Performance Creative & Performing Arts Program Scholarship

The High Performance Creative and Performing Arts Scholarship provides financial support to individuals who demonstrate a strong dedication to learning and an interest and commitment to the High-Performance Creative and Performing Arts Program.

To be eligible for a scholarship, current year 6 students must attend the High Performance Creative and Performing Arts Program trials in Term Two. This scholarship will include financial support of \$150 towards the recipients course charges per year from Year 7 to the completion of Year 10.

Scholarships are available to students in Major in the following Art disciplines: Visual Art, Music, Drama and Media.

High Performance Netball Program Scholarship

The High Performance Netball scholarship provides financial support to individuals who demonstrate a strong dedication to learning, and an interest and commitment to the High Performance Netball Program.

To be eligible for a scholarship, current year 6 students must attend the High Performance Netball Program Trial in Term Two. This scholarship will include financial support of \$150 towards the recipients course charges per year from Year 7 to the completion of Year 10.

Student Scholarships

High Performance Soccer Program Scholarship

The High-Performance Soccer scholarship provides financial support to individuals who demonstrate a strong dedication to learning, and an interest and commitment to the High Performance Soccer Program.

To be eligible for a scholarship, current year 6 students must attend the High Performance Soccer Program Trial in Term Two. This scholarship will include financial support of \$150 towards the recipients course charges per year from Year 7 to the completion of Year 10.

STEM Scholarship

The STEM Scholarship provides financial support to individuals who demonstrate a strong dedication to learning in Science.

This scholarship will include financial support of \$150 towards their course charges per year from Year 7 to the completion of Year 9. To continue to be eligible for the STEM scholarship, the recipient is required to remain in a STEM program from Year 7 to 9.

Kaartdijin Koolungah Scholarship

The Kaartdijin Koolungah Scholarship is available to students who are Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islanders origin and show a strong commitment to learning at the College. This will be evident through the student's attendance at school, a commitment to learning and involvement in College activities and community events through the Kaartdijin Koolungah program. This scholarship will include financial support of \$150 towards their course charges per year from Year 7 to the completion of Year 9.
