Joseph Banks Secondary College Student Scholarships - Senior School



Joseph Banks Secondary College has expanded our Scholarship categories to cater for the wide variety of High Performance and Specialised programs we offer. Students who are able to demonstrate achievement in fields of endeavour related to school life are encouraged to apply.

Please note that the following documentation is required to be submitted as part of the scholarship application **before the end of Term Two** to the Main Reception at Joseph Banks Secondary College:

- Application Form to be completed in the student's handwriting.
- Student's latest school report, a copy of which must be attached to the application form.
- Completed teacher reference and personal reference.

It is expected that scholarship recipients will demonstrate a high level of commitment to their studies and be positively involved within the College. An overview of each Senior School scholarship is provided below:

Academic Scholarship

Students who demonstrate strong academic performance will be eligible to apply for an Academic scholarship. This scholarship will include financial support of \$150 towards their course charges per year from Year 10 to the completion of Year 12.

Citizenship Scholarship

Students who are positively involved within the College and in the local community are eligible to apply for a Citizenship Scholarship. This scholarship will include financial support of \$150 towards their course charges per year from Year 10 to the completion of Year 12.

Year 10 P-TECH Cyber Solutions Scholarship

At Joseph Banks Secondary College we are consistently recognised for our excellence in STEM education. P-TECH Cyber Solutions is a unique pathway to creating a career in cyber security. This scholarship is open to current Year 9 students that are selecting our P-TECH Cyber Solutions pathway, which will include financial support of up to \$750 throughout their studies across years 10 -12.

To be eligible, students must commit to studying:

- Year 10 P-TECH Cyber Solutions course
- Certificate III Information Technology (Cyber Security) in Year 11 and 12
- At least two STEM subjects throughout Year 11 and 12, of which the Certificate III Information Technology (Cyber Security) counts as one.

Year 11 / 12 P-TECH Scholarship

This scholarship will be awarded to a current Year 10 student and will include financial support throughout their studies in year 11 and 12 up to the value of \$500

To be eligible, students must commit to studying:

- Certificate III Information Technology (Cyber Security) in Year 11 and 12
- At least two STEM subjects throughout Year 11 and 12, of which the Certificate III Information Technology (Cyber Security) counts as one.

To be considered for the P-TECH Scholarship students are required to provide:

- Student's latest school report, a copy of which must be attached to the application form.
- Application form, to be completed in the student's handwriting outlining why they should be considered for this specific scholarship.
- Teacher reference and evaluation sheet which must be sent directly to Joseph Banks Secondary College.

Women in Cyber Scholarship

This scholarship will be awarded annually to a female student who is studying a P-TECH pathway. This could be either Year 10 P-TECH Cyber Solutions or the Certificate III Information Technology (Cyber Security). The Scholarship will be for \$150.00 and will include financial support to cover course charges in Cyber related courses from Year 10 to the completion of Year 12.

The Women in Cyber Scholarship will include mentoring by a female industry expert.

To be considered for the Women in Cyber Scholarship students are required to provide:

- Student's latest school report, a copy of which must be attached to the application form.
- Application form, to be completed in the student's handwriting outlining why they should be considered for this specific scholarship.
- Teacher reference and evaluation sheet which must be sent directly to Joseph Banks Secondary College.

High Performance Academic Extension Program - ASPIRE Scholarship

The High-Performance Academic Extension Program Scholarship will provide financial support to students who demonstrate a strong dedication to learning.

To be eligible students must have achieved high standards in at least two categories of NAPLAN. This scholarship will include financial support of \$150 towards their course charges per year from Year 10 to the completion of Year 12.

Kaartdijin Koolungah Scholarship

The Kaartdijin Koolungah Scholarship is available to students who are Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islanders origin and show a strong commitment to learning at the College. This will be evident through the student's attendance at school, a commitment to learning and involvement in College activities and community events through the Kaartdijin Koolungah program. This scholarship will include financial support of \$150 towards their course charges per year from Year 10 to the completion of Year 12.
